****INCIDENTS****

Death Investigation – On February 15th at 9:48PM, police responded to the Waste Management Facility located at 7911 Notes Dr in Manassas (20109) for a found body. Staff reported to police that in the course of processing trash, a deceased adult male body was located. The body was transported to the medical examiners office for an autopsy. At this time, no foul play is suspected. The body was since been identified as 51 year old male, however, his name is being withheld until a next of kin is notified. Investigation continues.

Bomb Threat at a School – On February 15th at 12:33PM, police responded to Cedar Point Elementary School located at 12601 Braemar Pkwy in Bristow (20136) for a reported bomb threat. School staff located a note in one of the school's restrooms which indicated a threat. The school was evacuated of all students and school staff while a search by police was conducted. At 2:00PM, police concluded the search and no threat was located.

Burglary – On February 15th at 2:38PM, police responded to the 1600 block of Hylton Ave in Woodbridge (22191) for a burglary. Homeowner reported to police that the burglary occurred between 11:00AM and 2:30PM. Entry appeared to have been made through a side door which had been forced opened. A gaming console, related games and equipment, jewelry, a camera and TV, valued around \$10,000, were reported missing.

Burglary – On February 14th at 9:32AM, police responded to the 10200 block of Winchester Ct in Manassas (20109) for a burglary. Homeowner reported to police that the burglary occurred between 12:00PM on February 11th and 9:30AM on February 14th. There were no signs of forced entry into the residence. Entry is believed to have been made through an unsecured door. Two laptops and two TV's, valued around \$2,500, were reported missing.

****ARRESTS****

Narcotics Investigation – On January 12th, detectives from the Prince William Narcotics Task Force, which is comprised of detectives from Prince William County, Manassas City and Manassas Park, concluded a narcotics investigation into the selling of cocaine with the execution of two search warrants. The search warrants were executed at 10294 Copeland Dr in Manassas (20109) and at 132 Scott Dr in Manassas Park (20111). As a result of the two searches, cocaine and items supporting distribution were recovered. The accused was arrested on January 12th without incident. This arrest was previously held for investigative purposes.
